

COMMA KING GEORGE

THE PROJECT

Comma King George is situated in the Health and Technology District, located to the south of Surrey City Central. This development incorporates the restoration of the North Surrey Medical Building (1969), recently designated as a heritage site due to its exemplary mid-century modern architecture.

An interconnected three-story atrium links the new commercial establishments along King George Boulevard, fostering a lively atmosphere. Comma King George includes 392 rental units and features mixed-use residential and office/retail spaces. The addition of new homes with accompanying yards serves as a picturesque counterpoint to the commercial and public park areas.

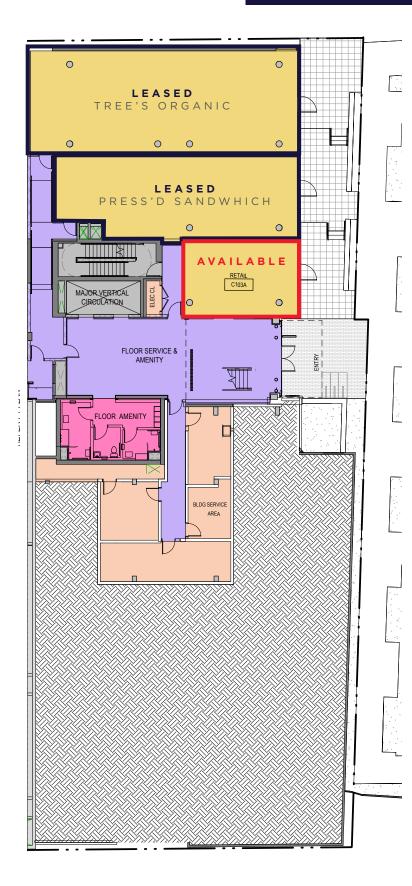
